Directions to Meeting from:

Hotel Deca – .8 mile from SCC

The hotel is a short cab ride to UW’s South Campus Center (SCC) (map).

Travel south on Brooklyn Ave. N.E., crossing N.E. Pacific St., to Boat St. (unmarked) along the water. Turn left. Make a right onto 15th Ave. N.E. and continue through the UW campus gatehouse. SCC (map) is on your right about 1/2 block. SCC parking garage is underneath before you get to the upper building entrance.

Silver Cloud Inn – 1.3 miles from SCC

The hotel is a short cab ride to the University of Washington’s South Campus Center (SCC) (map).

Travel south on 25th Ave. N.E. which becomes Montlake Blvd. N.E. Take far right lane onto N.E. Pacific St. Stay on N.E. Pacific St. until 15th Ave. N.E. Turn left and continue to Boat St. Keep left through the UW campus gatehouse. SCC (map) is on your right about 1/2 block. SCC parking garage is underneath before you get to the upper building entrance.

University Inn and Watertown Hotel – .75 mile from SCC

From Roosevelt, take NE 42nd Street east five blocks to 15th Avenue North. Turn right and go south five blocks to Boat Street (unmarked), then follow 15th as it curves around to the UW campus gatehouse. South Campus Center (SCC) parking garage is underneath before you get to the upper building entrance.

Walkers pass by the UW campus gatehouse heading straight on Columbia Road. Go up an incline about one block and turn right into the upper parking lot and entrance for SCC.

Directions to IVAR’s Salmon House from:

SCC – .75 mile from Ivar’s

Travel west along Boat St. to N.E. Pacific St. Turn left and go about 5 blocks to the stop sign at 6th Ave. N.E. Turn left onto 6th Ave. N.E., which becomes N.E. Northlake Way. IVAR’s is about one block on your left. This is a 20-minute walk.

Hotel Deca – 1.0 mile from Ivar’s

Travel south on Brooklyn Avenue N.E. to N.E. Pacific Street. Turn right and go about 5 blocks to the stop sign at 6th Ave. N.E. Turn left onto 6th Avenue N.E., which becomes N.E. Northlake Way. IVAR’s is about one block on your left.

Silver Cloud Inn – 2.0 miles from Ivar’s

Travel south on 25th Ave. N.E. which becomes Montlake Blvd. N.E. Take far right lane onto N.E. Pacific St. Stay on N.E. Pacific Street to the stop sign at 6th Ave. N.E. Turn left onto 6th Avenue N.E., which becomes N.E. Northlake Way. IVAR’s is about one block on your left.

University Inn and Watertown Hotel – .5 mile from Ivar’s

Head south on Roosevelt. Turn right at the sign: “To Westbound NE 40th” just before the University Bridge. Take first left (9th Ave) and then a right onto NE 40th. Go 2 blocks to 7th Ave. At the 5-way intersection, go left and down the hill one block to the stop sign. Turn left onto 6th Ave to the stoplight. Go straight through the T-intersection and curve around to the right onto Northlake Way. IVAR’S is about one block on your left.

Parking at IVAR’s Salmon House is available next to the restaurant or in the lot across the street.
